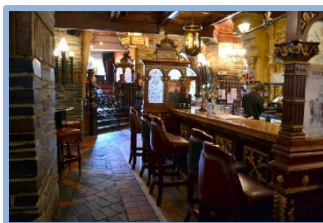
**May 4 - 3 nights -Depart Dublin for Sligo, Temple House, B & B**

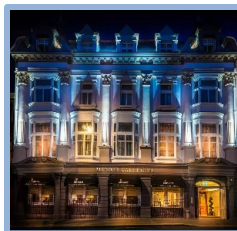
**May 7 - 3 nights-Derry, Northern Ireland, Bishops Gate Hotel B&B**
